Online Registration requires payment by Visa or Mastercard. For payments by check, cash, or money order, attend our in-person registration day or contact us to schedule an appointment. Checks should be payable to SMMPTA or the Santa Monica-Malibu Council of PTAs. Classes are not reserved until full payment is received. Scholarships are available to SMMUSD students. Students on the Federal Lunch Program can use the discount codes provided during registration and can upload their lunch letter as proof of eligibility within three days of registration. Students not on the Federal Lunch Program will see an option to apply for a need-based scholarship; the application and all required documentation (typically the prior year's tax return) must be provided within three days of registration to qualify. Summer Adventure is a half-day program and we do not provide after-care, though CDS provides on-site after-care through a separate registration process and space is limited. Tuition refunds can be requested through May 10th, but the \$75 registration fee is non-refundable. See our full policies and FAQ on our website.
